



## Member Spotlight Series: Submission Information

HxA's Member Spotlight series is an ongoing program where members present on their research, or a topic related to their area of expertise, and then take questions or lead conversations about the presentation. This series provides opportunities for HxA members to connect with others in our network, present to an open-minded audience, and learn about and engage with interesting topics.

Member Spotlight events take place virtually and run up to an hour in length. The format can be flexible, but our most successful sessions have opened with a 20–30-minute presentation followed by conversation and/or audience Q&A. Members can have their presentations recorded and shared publicly, but to ensure audience privacy, we do not record the conversation that follows.

We are open to submissions on a variety of topics and welcome new and unique takes. We are especially interested in topics that lend themselves to being viewed or analyzed through multiple viewpoints and create space for constructive conversation.

Considering HxA's varied membership, we ask that members keep in mind that they will be speaking to an audience from a variety of academic backgrounds and disciplines; the concepts should be presented in a way that is accessible to someone without prior knowledge.
